Exercises for everyone – Autumn in the park



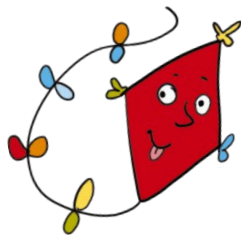
1. You see 5 ducks. 2 ducks fly away. How many ducks are left?
